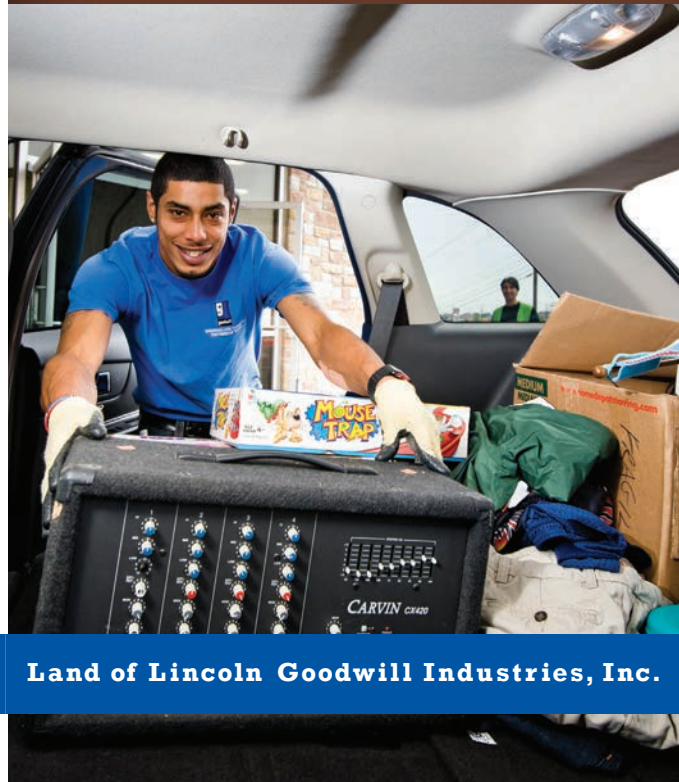

Donations are the lifeblood of the Goodwill mission. Generous donations of clothing, housewares, books, electronics, furniture and more contribute greatly to Goodwill's mission of helping others. Simply put, donations are sold at low prices to others, or are salvaged and recycled. Those dollars are used to fund programs that teach job skills, pay wages for jobs in our stores, create youth mentoring activities, and support services for those with intellectual disabilities.

DONATE. RECYCLE. GET A TAX BREAK

Most all donations stay local in each community providing those less fortunate with low cost clothing and goods. Items not worthy of being sold are either salvaged and sold to manufacturers to be repurposed, or are broken down and recycled, diverting millions of pounds each year from local landfills. And every donated item is tax deductible.

COMPUTER RECYCLING

Your old computers and computer peripherals may not have much value in your garage or basement, but at Goodwill they do. Through our partnership with Dell Reconnect, used and broken computer equipment can be dropped off at any Goodwill to be recycled.

Acceptable computer equipment you can donate include desktop and laptop computers, monitors, printers, ink and toner cartridges, keyboards, mice, speakers external hard drives, power cords, USB drives, servers and computer software CDs.

UNACCEPTABLE DONATIONS

Goodwill accepts most any donated item in most any condition, but there are some items we simply cannot accept because they either create a hazard for our employees, may contain unwanted insects or dangerous chemicals. Please review the list of items we CANNOT ACCEPT before bringing your donations to our store.

- Products Recalled by the Consumer Product Safety Commission
- Baby Items (Baby Beds, Car Seats, Walkers, Playpens)
- Bedding Items (Waterbeds, Metal Bed Springs, Mattresses, Box Springs, Electric Beds, Hospital Beds, Trundle Beds, or Day Beds)
- Chandeliers, Track Lighting, Wiring, Cable
- Carpet, Padding, Mini/Vertical Blinds, Curtain Rods, Valances
- Large Appliances (Refrigerators, Freezers, Washers, Dryers, Stoves, Dishwashers, Hoods, Furnaces, Air Conditioners, etc.)
- Toilets or Plumbing Fixtures
- Garage Door Openers, Garbage Disposals, Windows, Security Doors/Bars, Screen Doors, Sliding Doors
- Wall Cabinets, Awnings, Siding, Paneling, Work Tables/Benches, Pool Tables
