Volunteer positions with Goodwill are intended to supplement the work of paid staff, not replace employees. We offer many opportunities within the organization to give back while providing you with the experience you are looking and a personal level of satisfaction.

RETAIL & WAREHOUSE VOLUNTEERS

Volunteer opportunities exist in these departments for individuals seeking service hours for an educational or community group, who are required to volunteer to obtain government benefits, or who need court ordered service hours.

Retail store volunteers assist customers and help in processing donations. No experience is required. Examples of duties include preparing donations for sale, general cleaning, assisting shoppers and working on other special projects.

Warehouse volunteers assist in baling goods for salvage, helping unload and load trucks, and sorting donations. No experience is required, but volunteers must be able to push, lift and pull 50 lbs. in this more physical setting.

COMPUTER LAB VOLUNTEERS

With experience in Microsoft Office, volunteers help students and adults understand basic computer skills and the use of basic office software. Goodwill operates computer labs and Career Centers in Springfield, Bloomington, Danville, Litchfield, and Jacksonville.

OFFICE & CLERICAL VOLUNTEERS

There are many opportunities to volunteer your time inside our administrative headquarters in Springfield. Experience working in an office is a plus. Duties would include copying materials, filing, data entry, answering phones and assignment to some special projects.

COURT-ORDERED SERVICE

If you are required to perform court-ordered community service, or community service as part of a voluntary agreement with the State of Illinois, Goodwill wants to work with you.
